# Recycling



Please do not contaminate the recycling bins with non-recyclables!

Please do not bag recyclables, particularly with opaque bags – the automated monitoring systems on the trucks read these as contamination & the marina gets fined. "Wishful Recycling" tends to do more harm than good when we toss items that we wish would be recycled into the bins we risk contaminating the entire load which may just end up in the landfill instead.

- Please place only recyclable items in the recycling dumpsters. All other trash goes in the other bins.
- Please close the dumpster lids when you are finished. Open lids allows trash to spread!
- Please Do Not block the dumpsters with dock carts or debris. Blocked dumpsters don't get picked up and end up overflowing.
- Please take all hazardous waste items such as chemicals, batteries or electronics to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility.
